Who is eligible for the Gateway Grant?

High School graduates from Columbiana, Mahoning, Portage and Trumbull Counties who graduate with a 2.5 or higher GPA and attend full-time beginning with the summer or fall semester after graduation.

What does the Gateway Grant pay for?

It pays tuition for four successive full-time semesters (12 or more credit hours).

What else must I do?

You must apply for admission at www.EGCC.edu and complete the Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov. If you are eligible for a Federal Pell Grant, it will be applied to your student account first. Any remaining tuition charges will be covered by the Gateway Grant.
