

PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Presidential Scholarship program is open to high school seniors demonstrating outstanding academic achievement and exceptional aptitude. The results of the program will determine the eight students who will be the following year's University of Mount Union Presidential Scholars. Presidential Scholars are invited to exclusive events and learn from leaders in the professional world on a regular basis.

Presidential Scholars receive:

- A full-tuition Presidential Scholarship to Mount Union. The awards are based upon the tuition rate each year and are renewable for up to a total of four years (eight semesters), provided the recipient maintains a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
- Eligibility to participate in the University's Honors Program and special Honors activities and events.
- The opportunity to participate in future Presidential Scholarship programs as hosts and members of interview teams.

A merit-based scholarship or award is offered without regard for financial need. Students who may be eligible for multiple Mount Union scholarships and awards will receive at least the value of the highest scholarship or award.

Consideration that is given for any portion of a second scholarship or award from Mount Union will be based on financial need and will require that the student file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The maximum award equals full tuition; students who receive a full tuition scholarship are not eligible for additional Mount Union scholarships or awards. All University scholarships, awards, and grants are coordinated through the Office of Student Financial Services.

Following the NCAA Division III philosophy, the University of Mount Union does not offer athletic scholarships. The University does award scholarships and financial aid for student athletes on the same basis as it does for every other Mount Union student.

Eligibility

Any high school senior who has achieved an ACT score of at least **30** or SAT score of at least **1390** (EBRW + Math) **and** has earned a minimum grade point average of **3.75** is eligible to receive the University of Mount Union's full-tuition Presidential Scholarships.

How to Apply

1. Students who complete an application for admission to the University will be notified at the time of acceptance, or after acceptance and at the time of eligibility if prior to the program date, if they are eligible for the scholarship and will be invited to register for the event.
2. Eight candidates will be awarded full-tuition Presidential Scholarships. Remaining candidates will maintain their previously awarded Trustee Scholarship of \$18,000. All participating candidates will be notified of the program results by January 1, 2018.
3. Participation arrangements should be made in advance of the event. Candidates must schedule no later than one week prior to the event date.

The Program

The Presidential Scholarship program includes an on campus visit experience, complete with interviews and conversations with members of the Mount Union community, including faculty, staff, current Presidential and Trustee Scholars, and alumni.

Candidates and their parents will be guests of the University at a luncheon. Optional campus tours will be available.
