## ACADEMIC AWARDS

The following scholarships are based on a combination of academic performance, curriculum, standardized test scores (SAT/ACT,) and co-curricular activities. All Presidential Scholars will be selected by The Scholarship Committee.

- **Presidential Scholarship**  
Full Tuition (up to \$141,500 total or \$35,360/year)
- **Vance Scholarship**  
Up to \$84,000 (or \$21,000/year)
- **Tower Scholarship**  
Up to \$78,000 (or \$19,500/year)
- **Titan Scholarship**  
Up to \$70,000 (or \$17,500/year)
- **Trustee Scholarship**  
Up to \$62,000 (or \$15,500/year)
- **Lemmon Family Scholarship**  
Full Tuition (up to \$141,500 total or \$35,360/year)  
For students enrolling in a pre-health program. It is renewable with the maintenance of a 3.4 cumulative GPA and satisfactory academic progress.

## OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS

- **Legacy Scholarship**  
Up to \$74,000 (or \$18,500 per academic year)  
To be eligible, a student must present a minimum GPA of 3.0 and have a parent or grandparent who earned a degree from Westminster College.
- **Music Talent Award**  
Students with exceptional ability in music, who are music majors or minors, may receive a grant ranging from \$500 to \$2,000 for their participation. Interested students should contact the School of Music secretary, Kristen Kuzma, at 724-946-7270 or kuzmakm@westminster.edu.

## NOMINATED MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

- **Young Presbyterian Scholarship**  
Up to \$76,000 (or \$19,000 per academic year)  
To be eligible, a student must be a member of the Presbyterian Church USA, be nominated by his/her church, and present a minimum GPA of 3.5.
- **Presbyterian Heritage Scholarship**  
Up to \$72,000 (or \$18,000 per academic year)  
To be eligible, a student must be a member of a church whose roots can be traced back to the Presbyterian Church USA, be nominated by his/her church, and present a minimum GPA of 3.5.
- **Jerb Miller Scholarship**  
Up to \$76,000 (or \$19,000 per academic year)  
To be eligible, a student must be nominated by an educator who is a Westminster College grad and present a minimum GPA of 3.5.

*\*Most scholarships will be renewed for four years provided the student maintains the required GPA. Contact our admissions office for more details.*
