- 1 box of 12 plain #2 wooden pencils (sharpened) We recommend Ticonderoga brand.
- 4 large glue sticks (not bottles)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 boxes of thick Crayola markers
- 3 containers of Clorox clean-up wipes
- 1 box quart size zip-style storage bags
- 1 package dry erase markers

FIRST GRADE SUPPLIES LIST

- 2 Boxes of 24 crayons (**please no bigger boxes**)
- 24 Pack of pencils – Ticonderoga preferred
- 10 Glue Sticks
- Small bottle white Elmers Glue (if possible as others always clog)
- 2 durable pocket folders (1 take-home and 1 stay-here)
- 3 pocket folders **WITH PRONGS** (plastic preferred) 1 orange, 1 red, 1 purple
- 1 box of water based markers
- 2 highlighters – 1 pink and 1 yellow
- 2 low odor dry erase markers – blue or black (Expo preferred)

- 1 box zip-style **gallon** storage bags (boys)
